Early Macintosh	Red	End Jan	Small – medium. Good colour, flavour. Originating in Ontario Canada. Scented, white flesh. America's favourite apple for a long time. The apple on the computers!
Egremont Russet	Russet	March	Small. Very sweet. Dry, rich flesh. Crisp, keeps well. England's most important russet variety
Five Crown	Green / Yellow	End March	Low acidity, cooks well, crisp
Geeveston Fanny Red	Red	Feb / March	Good eating. Originates from Geeveston Tasmania.
George Carpenter	Red striped	March / April	Sweet / tart – Borry's favourite
Glowing Coal	Bright red	Jan / Feb	Small. Prolific crop
Gravenstein	Red stripe on green / yellow	End Jan	Crisp, eating apple. Aromatic, medium-large, sweet subacid
Hubbardsons Nonsuch	Large green cooker / eating		
Irish Peach	Red	Early Feb	Small. Prolific, sweet subacid. Good eating.
Keswick Early Codlin	Green	Late Jan	Transparent
King Cole	Bright red	End Jan	
King David	Yellow Flesh	Jan / Feb	Medium size from Arkansas. Firm, prominently red striped. Spicy, aromatic flavour
Lady of the Snows or Pomme de Neigre	Red strip on green, with pure white flesh	March	From Canada. Small, flat apple, white flesh, good flavours, lightly aromatic, sweet subacid. Possibly the apple in Snow White!

Lady's Finger	Green	Jan / Feb	Elongated long apple, very much a finger shape.
Opalescent	Bright red	April	Good flavour, colour
Peasgood Nonsuch	Red	March	Huge. Eating , cooking

Rome Beauty	Striped deep red		Medium – large. Very sweet. Rome in upstate N.Y. Classic apple – good flavours, crisp, keeps well.
Stayman Black Winesap	Dark red	April	Good eating
Stayman's Winesap	Pink / red	March	Famous old U.S apple (1850). Used to store all winter. Distinct vinous (winesap) flavour
Twenty Ounce	Green / red stripe		Name implies its weight. Queen Victoria said "What an amazing fruit"
Tydman's Early Worster	Full red	Feb	Medium. Beautiful, full. Quite conical in shape. Good eating, fragrant, sweet.
